

SCULPT AWAY BODY FAT WITH LIPO THERAPY

A fast, easy, inexpensive alternative to liposuction

Have you ever wondered when someone would invent a fast, easy and inexpensive alternative to liposuction? Well, someone did and it's called Lipotherapy with lipodissolve. This procedure, which is a series of small injections, has become accepted as a safe, minimally invasive alternative to surgical Liposuction throughout the world. Lipotherapy with lipodissolve offers a non-surgical cosmetic approach for reducing localized fat deposits. Because there is no surgery, there is no risk of anesthesia and no post surgical down time. The treatment involves a series of small injections used to sculpt areas where stubborn body fat accumulates and will not easily respond to exercise and diet alone.

While lipotherapy is not a weight loss program, people with localized areas of fat accumulation will greatly benefit from this procedure.

What is Lipodissolve?

Lipodissolve is made from the chemical phosphatidylcholine, which increases the rate of cellular fat metabolism and breaks down fat cells. By breaking down fat cells, the fat is emptied from the areas where it has lead to unsightly fat accumulations and is metabolized and released from the body through the kidneys and the digestive tract. Phosphatidylcholine is the chief component of soy lecithin, a natural ingredient that breaks down fat.

Is Phosphatidylcholine Safe?

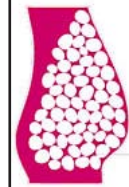
Phosphatidylcholine is a natural ingredient which when injected into fat results in inflammation and the break down of fat. This inflammation causes pain, temporary bruising, itching, and swelling at the site of injection for 2 – 3 days. This inflammation is necessary for the breakdown of fat. Thousands of patients throughout the world have now experienced lipotherapy with lipodissolve and physicians administering this treatment have been impressed with both its results and safety. There are no known long-term systemic side effects of Phosphatidylcholine.

People who are diabetic, pregnant, highly obese, on medication, suffering from a serious illness or allergic to the product should not have Lipodissolve injections. Also, patients should not take anti-inflammatory medication while undergoing their sessions as this reduces inflammation and limits the clinical effectiveness of the treatments.

Is the fat removal permanent?

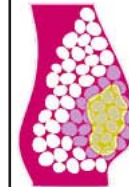
Phosphatidylcholine opens the fat cell, allowing fat to be eliminated from the cell. Studies show that with lipodissolve, fat cells are permanently removed through the treatment. They are flushed out of the body through the urinary and gastrointestinal tract. One must be careful to prevent weight gain as with weight gain, new fat can reappear. A balanced diet and exercise is recommended to expedite fat metabolism.

How It Works



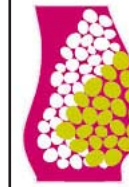
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Over time, fat cells accumulate where we least want them, around our middle, the buttocks, thighs, arms, or chin.



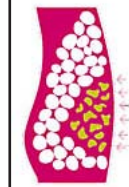
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To dissolve those pockets, micro-injections of phosphatidylcholine are delivered into the target treatment area.



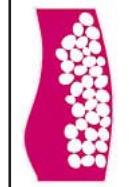
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The fat cells absorb the phosphatidylcholine and become slightly inflamed, then harden. This means it's working.



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The hardened fat cells break down within a few weeks and they are then excreted through the body.



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Over the course of the treatment period, the fat cells in the targeted area are permanently eliminated from the body.

What areas of fat can be treated?

Areas of treatment may include fat pads under the eyes, the jaw line, back of the arms, midsection, bra line and parts of the thighs, including inner thighs, saddlebags, and around the knees.

Both women and men can benefit from the treatment. The optimal patient is active, with small areas of fat, rather than overall weight to lose. However, people who are overweight and have localized areas of fat may benefit as well.

On average, patients begin to see

results after 4 treatments, usually spaced 1 to 2 weeks apart. Their desired effects will usually be achieved after 4 to 10 treatments, depending on their sensitivity to the Phosphatidylcholine. Treatments may include from 2 to 8 syringes of lipodissolve with each syringe priced at \$50, making it a very affordable procedure.

Lipotherapy with Lipodissolve: Frequently asked questions

How many treatments are required?

Generally, patients require eight to ten treatments. However, some may require fewer or more treatments. People generally begin to see changes in the treated area after four treatments. Often the patient's clothing will become looser and friends and family will tell the patient they appear thinner after several treatments.

Can I go back to work after the treatment? Are the treatments painful?

The procedure generally takes 30 minutes or less and requires no preparation or recovery time - so you can go back to work after the treatment. Most patients experience minimal discomfort, however Tylenol or other pain medication can be used if needed.

How is this procedure different from liposuction?

Besides involving no anesthesia and surgical risk, lipotherapy requires no recovery time. The gradual effects of the treatment allow the skin to retract and tighten as fat is removed. Lipotherapy also can be used post liposuction.

Do my hormones have any effect on this procedure?

Hormone imbalances are often part of the core problem leading to weight gain and excess body fat and need to be corrected to have maximum benefits. If the underlying physiology is corrected and maintained, then Lipotherapy is done in an initial series. If it recurs, then the process will need to be repeated.

Is this procedure FDA approved?

All components are FDA approved for specific conditions. In Lipotherapy, we use the medications or ingredients "off-label," which is every physician's prerogative. This is similar to initial use of Botox for cosmetic reasons.

Are there any side effects?

There is a potential for transient rapid heart beat, dizziness, nausea, and sweatiness. This is more likely to occur if the patient has not eaten prior to the treatments. Patients can expect signs of inflammation, including redness, swelling, itching, and tenderness. With Lipotherapy with lipodissolve, there is a chance that there will be a lowering of the cholesterol level.
